

COMMODITY SUPPLEMENTAL FOOD PROGRAM

CSFP provides a monthly kit of nutritious food to eligible seniors.

What is CSFP?

The Commodity Supplemental Food Program (CSFP) provides supplemental food every month to low-income seniors.

Eligible seniors receive two bags of food once per month, totaling about 30 to 35 pounds. The bags include fruits, vegetables, cheese, milk, peanut butter/dry beans, cereal, juice, protein and potatoes/grains. Sometimes the food bank can supplement the food bags with fresh produce and other goods donated by other sources.

Eligibility Requirements

- 60 years of age or older
- Resident of Glades or Hendry County
- Gross income at or below 130% of the federal poverty guidelines (see chart)

Federal Poverty Guidelines

Household Size	Annual	Monthly	Weekly
1	\$15,678	\$1,307	\$302
2	\$21,112	\$1,760	\$406
3	\$25,564	\$2,213	\$511
For each additional person...	\$5,434	\$453	\$105

What is needed to apply?

- Photo ID (ex: driver license, state-issued ID, passport)*
*If photo ID does not list current address, must also provide documentation of current address (ex: lease or phone bill)
- An additional form is required if someone other than the applicant will be picking up the food.
